#### Clinical Education Day

Presented in partnership with the FSHD Society and the University of Kansas Medical Center in Kansas City, Kansas - April 10, 2026

We invite you to join us for the first **Clinical Education Day**, an in-depth educational program designed for clinicians and mid-level providers. This half-day event will take a comprehensive look at neuromuscular repeat expansion diseases, with a focus on myotonic dystrophy (DM), facioscapulohumeral muscular dystrophy (FSHD), and other muscular dystrophies.

Clinical Education Day will offer three hours of Continuing Medical Education (CME) credit and will feature expert-led sessions that advance clinical knowledge and practical skills to improve patient care. The program is co-hosted by the Myotonic Dystrophy Foundation and the FSHD Society in partnership with the University of Kansas Medical Center.

By sponsoring Clinical Education Day, you will help provide clinical attendees the opportunity to:
