Seeking Adolescents Diagnosed with Myotonic Dystrophy Type 1 (DM1) for Interview Study

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE STUDY?

To better understand the experiences of those living with DM1, and to get feedback on questionnaires that may be used in future studies of new treatments for DM1.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Adolescents (12-17 years old) living in the US who have received a diagnosis of DM1
 - Willing and able to participate in a 90-minute interview (web-based or telephone) in English
- Other eligibility criteria may apply*
