Abstracts are to be original work, cannot have been presented at a prior conference and must be submitted as a Word file with the following sections:

1. Abstract title
2. Authors, with presenting author's name underlined
3. Author affiliations
4. Abstract body (**not to exceed 250 words**)
 1. Objective
 2. Methodology
 3. Results
 4. Conclusions
